There are restrictions as to what can be collected and transported. Oil, paint and anti-freeze need to be in closed containers. If bringing car or boat batteries, a cardboard box would be appreciated (but not necessary). We *cannot* take light bulbs, fertilizer or other chemicals *at this location*. Questions?
