Thanksgiving Potluck

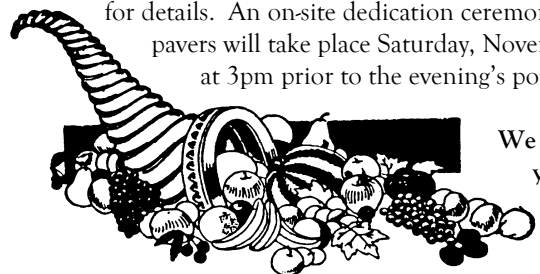
