

## TRAVIS COUNTY TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS ON REDISTRICTING

Travis County will hold a series of public hearings to allow the community to give input on the redistricting plan to be adopted by the Commissioners Court on or about August 23, 2011. The new plan must reflect changes in Travis County demographics as reported in the latest Census data to ensure an accurate representation of the voting public.

- **A fifth hearing will be held at the Travis County Commissioners Court, 314 W. 11<sup>th</sup> Street, First Floor, Austin, TX on Tuesday, July 12. In addition to general input this hearing will also include proposed justice of the peace/constable district maps and will provide a designated opportunity for the leadership of racial, language, and other groups representing established communities of interest to provide input.**
